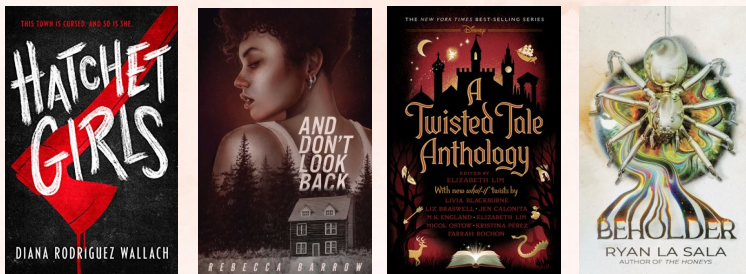

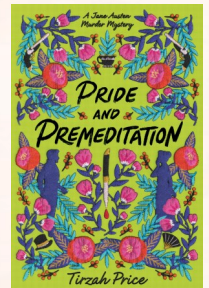

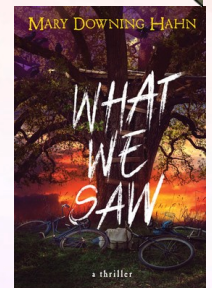

## Kim's Book Pick



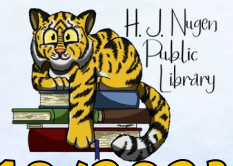

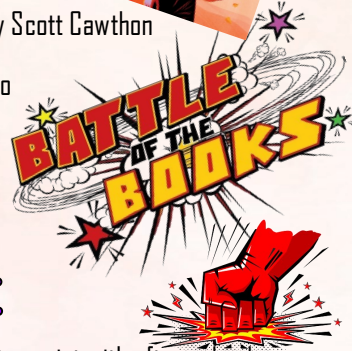
